

Team Sopris Barracuda Jessica Tuttle competed on the Las Vegas Invitational Swim Meet last weekend, swimming personal records in seven of eight preliminary races and six of six final races; she recorded seven Team Sopris records, qualified for national-level meets in Florida and Texas, and earned a USA Swimming Scholastic All-America qualifying time in the 400 individual medley, winning the women's open division by three seconds in 4:27.56, an eight-second improvement over her previous best. Tuttle also took second in the 200 fly (2:06.54), fourth in the 200 im (2:09.58), and sixth in the 500 (5:08.07) and 1000 (10:36.85) freestyles. Based upon the team records, it appears that Jessica's Scholastic All-America qualifying time may be the first by a Sopris Swimmer. Well done, Jessica.
